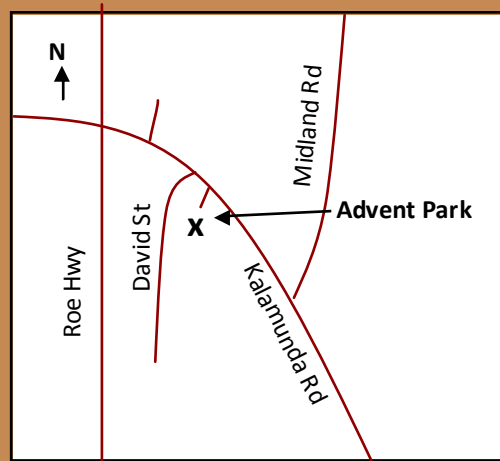
If Christians are free are the Ten Commandments still relevant?
